Gustine Municipal Code 4-38-70 Section G.3

<u>Political signs:</u> Temporary political signs shall comply with the following requirements.

- a. **Maximum size.** No political sign shall exceed 16 square feet in area; and if freestanding, no more than six feet in height.
- b. **Prohibited locations for posting.** No political sign shall be a roof sign, and no political sign shall be posted on, under, above, or across any public property, or within or above a public right-of-way.
- c. **Property owner approval required.** No political sign shall be posted without the approval of the property owner; provided that no property owner shall approve or allow more than an aggregate of 80 square feet of political signs per lot of record.
- d. **Time limits.** No political signs shall be posted earlier than 45 days prior to the election at which the candidates or measures will be voted upon, and each sign shall be removed within seven days after the election.
- e. Enforcement of removal requirements. If a sign is not removed, notice shall be issued and the responsible party shall remove the sign within seven days of the notice to remove the sign. If not removed within that time, violations are punishable in compliance with Municipal Code Title 1, Chapter 1.16.
