Last Day for Measure Consolidation (Requested Deadline) March 1, 2016 E-98	Resolution Requesting Measure Consolidation - must be submitted to the Board of Supervisors; a copy of the resolution is to be provided to the Registrar of Voters (ROV). Resolution to include: Request for ROV to provide services, ballot question (75 word limit), passage requirements, full text (including Tax Rate Statement and Fiscal Impact Report, if applicable). Cities - Impartial Analysis to be filed with resolution. Schools & Districts – County elections official will request Analysis. EC 9160, 9222, 9280, 9313, 9500, 10403
March 2 – March 9 E-97 – E-90	Publication – Notice of election date, ballot question, primary & rebuttal argument deadlines: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • County, School & Special District Measures, the required notice will be published by the Registrar of Voters. EC 9163, 9502 • Municipal Measures, the City Clerk will publish the required notice. Note: City Measures do not have to have rebuttal arguments, unless the city adopts provisions for rebuttals. Late Period Measure Consolidation (Legal Deadline) March 2 – March 11 E-97 - E-88	Late Period - Measure Consolidation Requests Measure Consolidations received after the Requested Deadline through 5:00 p.m. on the Legal Deadline (E-88) are considered Late Period Requests. Argument filing deadlines will be adjusted and shortened to allow for publication, receipt of arguments, public examination periods, translations, and preparation of official voter materials prior to the first day for Military and Overseas ballot mailings.
March 16, 2016 5:00 p.m. on E-83	Deadline: <u>Primary</u> Arguments In Favor or Against Argument deadlines may be different for City Measures, in non-statewide elections, check with the City Clerk. If measure is filed after E-98 (3/1) , deadline will be adjusted to E-78 (3/21) . GC 57146; EC 9162, 9286(b), 9316, 9502
March 16, 2016 E-83	Deadline: Amendment or Withdrawal of Measure The governing body may amended or withdrawn a measure by filing of a resolution with the elections official. If the measure qualified by the initiative or referendum process, a written withdrawal notice signed by all proponents must be filed. EC 9604, 9605
March 17 – March 28 E-82 – E-71	10-Day Public Examination Period for Primary Arguments (Deadline adjusted for weekend.) EC 9190, 9380, 9286, 9295, 9509
March 25, 2016 5:00 p.m. on E-74	Deadline: <u>Rebuttal</u> to Arguments In Favor or Against There will only be a rebuttal argument filing period, if both an argument in favor <u>and</u> an argument against are filed during the primary argument period. If measure is filed after E-98 (3/1) , deadline will be adjusted to E-71 (3/28) . EC 9163, 9167, 9285, 9286, 9316, 9317, 9502, 9504
March 26 – April 4 E-73 – E-64	10-Day Public Examination Period for Rebuttal Arguments EC 9190, 9380, 9286, 9295, 9509
April 8, 2016 E-60	Military & Overseas Voter Information & Ballot Mailing starts. EC 3105
June 7, 2016	Election Day EC 1000
