* A Land Use Permit approved by Planning & Community Development is a "conditional" permit. The permit holder is required to comply with all conditions of the Land Use Permit imposed by other County Departments .

Building & Safety Division may issue septic systems together with building permits with specifications approved by Environmental Health.

1. All Building Permits are subject to review by Planning and Community Development.

2. All Building Permits which include new structures or additions to existing structures are subject to review by the Fire Department.

3. All Building Permits which include access from a County Road or a State Highway are subject to review by Roads Division.

Access from a State Highway is also subject to review by Cal-Trans.

4. All Building Permits which include or affect a septic system, grease trap or well, are subject to review by Environmental Health Division.
5. All Businesses operating in the unincorporated area of Merced County are required to possess a valid Merced County Business License.
6. Fire Department will review all swimming pools, ponds, water storage tanks or other forms of water storage intended for use for on-site fire suppression.
7. Conditional Use Permits may require Environmental Review (C.E.Q.A.) by an outside consultant to comply with requirements of agencies such as CA Department of Fish & Game, Environmental Protection Agency, etc,
8. Transportation permits are required to move buildings, mobile homes and commercial coaches on County Roads.
9. Wells run on electricity, solar or generators will also require a Building Permit. Wells run on generators or motors may also require a permit from the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District.
10. If a project is located within the flight path of an airport or part of a airport land use study, review and approval by the appropriate airport land use commission is required.
11. Special Events includes, but is not limited to: circuses, concerts, dances, fairs, community events, etc.
12. Cal-Trans will review all projects which have access from a State owned road or highway or are near intersections with a State owned road or highway where traffic flow from a project may have an adverse impact on existing roadways.
