Results of the 'Future Land Use' Workshop
November 7, 2011**

General Information

- 43 People attended the workshop and used the 'signup sheets'.
- Very few people did not sign in
- 23 sets of written comments were received.
- 20 comments were submitted in English, 3 in Spanish.

Question 1 – What Plan did you like the best?

Votes

Alternative 1 – Existing Plan: No change in urban boundary and land uses	1
Alternative 2 – Balanced Growth: New homes and local job opportunities	9
Alternative 3 - Regional Growth – Provides for regional job growth, retail and housing	12

Question 2 – What Plan did you like the least?

Votes

Alternative 1 – Existing Plan: No change in urban boundary and land uses	14
Alternative 2 – Balanced Growth: New homes and local job opportunities	0
Alternative 3 - Regional Growth – Provides for regional job growth, retail and housing	8

Question 3 – What changes would you recommend?

People who wanted nothing to change in Le Grand were a very small minority of responses. More responses stressed the importance of retaining the existing character of Le Grand – it's walking lifestyle and small town feel. Many respondents stressed the need for Le Grand to have more jobs, retail and recreation.

Question 4 – What else is important?

Improved water supply, sidewalks, street lighting, preserve and improve the existing community (end blight), improved medical and sheriff services, more jobs, businesses and stores.
