**Winton Community Plan
Results of the 'Future Land Use' Workshop
October 19, 2011**

General Information

- 56 People attended the workshop and used the 'signup sheets'.
- Staff estimate that approximately 10 people did not 'sign in'
- 22 sets of written comments were received.
- 21 comments were submitted in English, 1 in Spanish.

Question 1 – What Plan did you like the best?

Alternative 2 – Balanced Growth: New homes and local job opportunities	10
Alternative 3 - Regional Growth – Provides for regional job growth, retail and housing	10

Question 2 – What Plan did you like the least?

Alternative 1 – Existing Plan: No change in urban boundary and land uses	17
Alternative 2 – Balanced Growth: New homes and local job opportunities	1
Alternative 3 - Regional Growth – Provides for regional job growth, retail and housing	3
No Response	1

Question 3 – What changes would you recommend?

Most people who responded saw change in Winton as being necessary and desirable. People wanted to see more sidewalks, streets in good repair, more parks and a lively, attractive downtown. Strong support was expressed for more and better job opportunities, and encouraging businesses to build ties with the local community.

Question 4 – What else is important?

Improved sheriff service and better street lighting. Reduced traffic speed on Winton Way and improvement in its appearance. Encourage more attractive streets and landscaping. Produce a different image for Winton – "A Clean and Honest Town".
