SUBJECT: Emergency Public Works Project To Replace Drinking Water Well at John Latorraca Correctional Facility – Continuance of Emergency

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

- 1) Find that substantial evidence demonstrates that an emergency continues to exist regarding the drinking water well at the John Latorraca Correctional Center (JLCC) such that the emergency will not permit a delay resulting from a competitive solicitation for bids, and that the action to replace the drinking water well is necessary to respond to the emergency. (4/5 vote required)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On July 13, 2021, the Board of Supervisors found that substantial evidence demonstrated a public works emergency existed regarding the drinking water well serving the Merced County John Latorraca Correctional Center (JLCC).

A contract is in place with Shannon Pump Co. to provide well development, pump installation, and necessary plumbing and electrical work for the project. A contract with Quality Well Drillers is in place to drill and install the replacement drinking water well at the JLCC. A contract with Stantec Consulting Services Inc. has been executed for permitting and construction oversight. The preliminary estimate for development and installation of the replacement drinking water well, monitoring of the installation, permit fee, and other ancillary costs associated with the project is \$1,200,000. Due to delivery delays of necessary components and inspection scheduling for the project, the project is estimated to be complete by June 30, 2022.

STAFFING IMPACT: None by this action.

FISCAL IMPACT: Funding in the amount of \$1,200,000 was appropriated in 17000/81394 on July 13, 2021.
