SUBJECT: California Victims Compensation Board Agreement

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

- 1) Approve the District Attorney’s continued participation in the Criminal Restitution Program; and
- 2) Authorize the District Attorney, Kimberly R.H. Lewis, to sign Amendment No. 1 to Contract No. 2019179 (State Agreement No. VC-9069), extending the term end date from June 30, 2022 to June 30, 2023 and increasing the contract amount from \$229,758 to \$306,344

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On June 4, 2019 the District Attorney’s office was granted permission to participate in the Criminal Restitution Program for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022. This program provides funding for part of a paralegal who time studies to the function of this grant. The paralegal secures restitution orders in all appropriate cases involving victims who have files claims with the California Victims Compensation Board.

The California Victim Compensation Board has modified Contract No. 2019179 (State Agreement No. VC-9069) for continued participation in this program, for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.
