The project site is located east of the City of Atwater and immediately northeast of Castle Airport. It is bounded by Eucalyptus Avenue to the north, Buhach Road to the west and Canal Creek to the east, designated Agricultural in the General Plan and Zoned A-1 (General Agricultural) and A-2 (Exclusive Agricultural)
