### November 4, 2014 Gubernatorial General Election

#### Last Day to Register to Vote

- **October 20, 2014** is the last day to register to vote, postmarks are acceptable.

#### Vote by Mail Ballot Processing

- On or after **October 6, 2014**, signatures will be verified on all returned voted vote by mail ballot envelopes.
- Starting on **October 24, 2014**, voted ballot returned as good will be opened by staff at the Merced County Election's Warehouse located 250 E. 15th Street, Merced, CA 95341.
- Starting on **October 30, 2014**, vote by mail ballots will be tabulated at the Merced County Election's Warehouse.

#### Election Night November 4, 2014 Semi-Official Results

- Ballots voted at the polls will be tabulated at the Merced County Election's Warehouse after the polls close on Election Night.
- Semi-Official results will be released shortly after 8:00 p.m. via hardcopy, phone and on our website at [www.mercedelections.org](http://www.mercedelections.org).

#### Official Canvass

- The official canvass process for the above named election will take place at the Merced County Election's Warehouse, starting **November 5, 2014** and will continue until completed.

#### One Percent Manual Tally

- The random draw of precincts for the 1% manual tally will be held at 8:30 a.m. on **Friday, November 7, 2014** at the Merced County Election's Warehouse, 250 E. 15th Street, Merced, CA 95341.
- The one percent manual tally of the selected precincts for above named election will take place at the Merced County Election's Warehouse, starting shortly after the random draw. The tally will continue for 6 hours per day, Monday through Friday, except for state holidays, until completed.

AND COMMENCEMENT OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT PROCESSING

As per Elections Code § 12109, notice is hereby given that at the **Gubernatorial General Election** to be held on **November 4, 2014**, all voted ballots will be counted on ES&S M100 precinct counters at each polling location and the results will be accumulated on the Merced County Registrar of Voters computer after the polling locations close on Election Day. Said computer is located in the **Merced County Elections Warehouse at 250 S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Merced CA.**

The polling locations will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

As per Elections Code § 15104, the Registrar of Voters also, hereby notifies all interested organizations that the verifying of signatures on vote by mail ballots cast for the **Gubernatorial General Election** will commence on **October 6, 2014**, or at any time thereafter in the **Merced County Elections Warehouse, 250 E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Merced, CA.** Starting **October 24, 2014**, or at any time thereafter, the opening and processing of vote by mail ballots will commence. This process will continue until all election results are tabulated and the election is certified.

Any member of the county grand jury, and any other interested organization, shall be permitted to observe and challenge the manner in which the vote by mail ballots are handled, from the processing of ballot return envelopes through the opening, counting and disposition of the ballots.
