

Notice of Central Count and Mail Ballot Processing  
(Elections Code 12109 & 15104)

On May 5, 2015 a Mail Ballot Election will be held for Merced Union High School Governing Board, Area 3. Ballots will be counted at the Merced County Elections Warehouse, 250 E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Merced. Results will not be available until after 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Starting April 6, 2015, signatures on returned ballot envelopes will be compared with voter file signatures. If the signature compares, the ballot will be processed. Ballot processing activities start April 21, 2015. Processing includes opening envelopes, preparing and counting ballots. Each activity will continue, as needed, until all ballots are counted and the election is certified.

Interested groups and individuals have the right to observe ballot handling activities. These activities will take place in the Merced County Elections Warehouse, 250 E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Merced. An observer entrance will be open whenever ballot handling activities are in progress.
